

ORDINANCE 2012-08

***An Ordinance Amending Title 1, Chapter 8, Article A-2-E
to the Municipal Code of the Village of West Dundee, Illinois,
Appointment of Part Time Police Officers***

WHEREAS, the Village of West Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, is a home rule municipality as contemplated under article VII, Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and the passage of this Ordinance constitutes an exercise of the Village's home rule powers and functions as granted in the Constitution of the State of Illinois;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES, VILLAGE OF WEST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS that:

Section 1: The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated in this Article A-2-E as if said recitals were fully set forth herein.

Section 2: A Section 1-8A-2-E shall be and is hereby added to Title 1, Chapter 8 of the West Dundee Municipal Code and read as follows:

Sec. 1-8A-2-E. Part Time Police Officers:

1. Employment. The Village of West Dundee may employ part-time police officers from time to time as they deem necessary.
2. Duties. A part-time police officer shall have all the responsibilities of a full-time police officer and such specific duties as delineated in the General Orders of the West Dundee Police Department, but the number of hours a part-time police officer may work within a calendar year is restricted. Part-time police officers shall not be assigned to supervise or direct full-time police officers. Part-time police officers shall be trained in accordance with the Illinois Police Training Act (50 ILCS 705/1 et. Seq.) and the rules and requirements of the ILETSB.
3. Hiring Standards. Any person employed as a part-time police officer must meet the following standards:
 - a. Be of good moral character, of temperate habits, of sound health, and physically and mentally able to perform assigned duties.
 - b. Be at least twenty-one (21) years of age.
 - c. Pass a medical examination.
 - d. Possess a high school diploma or GED certificate.
 - e. Possess a valid State of Illinois driver's license.
 - f. Possess no prior felony convictions.
 - g. Any individual who has served in the U.S. military must have been honorably discharged.
4. Discipline. Part-Time police officers shall be under the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Chief of Police. Part-time police officers serve at the discretion of the Village of West Dundee authorities, shall not have any property rights in said employment, and may be removed by the Village of West Dundee authorities at any time. Part-time police officer shall comply with all applicable rules and General Orders issued by the West Dundee Police Department.


Section 3: Any policy, resolution or ordinance of city, or any part thereof, that conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


Section 4: The ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
