

ORDINANCE 2013-20

An Ordinance Amending Section 6-1-18 of the Municipal Code of the Village of West Dundee, Illinois, Adding Video Gaming Signage Provisions

WHEREAS, the Village of West Dundee, Kane County, Illinois is a home rule municipality as contemplated under Article VII, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and the passage of this Ordinance constitutes an exercise of the Village's home rule powers and functions as granted in the Constitution of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Video Gaming Act (230 ILCS 40/1) became law on July 13, 2009 by virtue of P.A. 96-0034; and,

WHEREAS, the Illinois Gaming Board is authorized by the Act to license video gaming terminals and to promulgate regulations related to their operation; and,

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of West Dundee approved Ordinance 2010-07 on March 15, 2010 prohibiting video gaming in the Village, pursuant to Section 27 of the Video Gaming Act; and,

WHEREAS, local liquor establishments licensed by the Village of West Dundee submitted a petition dated November 12, 2012, requesting that the Village President and Board of Trustees reevaluate this prohibition and allow video gaming within the Village; and,

WHEREAS, after significant discussion, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of West Dundee approved Ordinance 2013-01 on February 4, 2013 allowing video gaming in the Village; and,

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of West Dundee believes that provisions regulating signage related to video gaming will be of benefit to the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES, VILLAGE OF WEST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS that:

Section 1: The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated in this Section One as if said recitals were fully set forth herein.

Section 2: Section 6-1-18 shall be and is hereby amended by adding paragraph C. Video Gaming Signage Provisions, as follows:

6-1-18: VIDEO GAMING:

C. Video Gaming Signage Provisions:

1. No reference to video gaming or video poker is permitted for any permanent free standing, surface mounted or window signage for any licensed establishment.
2. Video gaming references are permitted for temporary window signage at no more than 9 square feet per commercial frontage. All other temporary sign

provisions are restricted from including any references to gaming, video gaming or video poker.


Section 3: Any policy, resolution or ordinance of city, or any part thereof, that conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


Section 4: The ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
