



GENERATOR

BUILDING DEPARTMENT PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

REQUIREMENTS:

1. A completed permit application
2. A plat of survey indicating the location of generator including the distances to lot lines or other structures.
3. Indicate size of generator to be installed.
4. Indicate size of conductors and conduit being used.
5. Indicate distance from doors, windows and/or any other building openings.
6. Indicate size of gas line or other type of fuel being used.
7. Provide manufactures installation instructions for generator being installed.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- A gas shut-off shall be located within six feet (6') of generator.
- Gas line shall be protected physical damage where located above grade.
- Gas line shall be buried a minimum of 18" inches below grade and shall be wrapped with a minimum of 18 AWG yellow insulated tracer wire.
- Generator shall not be located in any utility or drainage easements.

REQUIRED INSPECTIONS:

- Underground electric and gas if applicable
- Final

NOTE:

- An electrician shall be on site at time of inspection to test generator.

PERMIT FEES:

The fee for this permit shall be \$50.00 for residential.

Commercial base fee of \$150.00 minimum or 3% of total cost of construction.

Note: A fee for plan review may be applicable.

Individual subdivision covenants may have special requirements.
